## Case Studies

#### Council House 2 (CH2), Melbourne

Council House 2 (CH2) in Melbourne is Australia's first six star energy rated building. It harvests rain water to cool the building down and maximises natural lighting to reduce lighting energy consumption. As evening approaches, a state- of-the-art energy management system configured with Moonlighting's low wattage fluorescent lights ramp up to provide required levels of light, and the use of occupancy sensors ensures lights are turned off automatically when offices and surrounding areas are not occupied.

## Street Lighting Project, Coff's Harbour

Sylvania Lighting teamed with Coffs Harbour Council and Country Energy in NSW in a project to implement energy efficient lighting. The trial was so successful that it won the 2002 Local Government Excellence in the Environment Award for Energy Efficient and Greenhouse Projects and lead to a rollout of the new energy efficient lights through the entire area in 2004. Mr. Jeff Green, Environmental Services Manager of Coffs Harbour Council is guoted as saying:

"The savings are significant both financially and for the environment. The council should save at least 15% on annual street lighting costs.

But even more impressive are the environmental benefits. Our forecasts show that we will reduce greenhouse gas emission by 35% which equates to 650 tonnes eC02 per annum".

As a part of the Coffs Harbour project, a model was created that predicts both the savings in greenhouse emissions and the financial benefits.

Opened in 1921, Memorial Drive is one of the world's great tennis clubs and the headquarters of South Australian tennis. The complex is located in the heart of Adelaide.

The Memorial Drive Tennis Centre has been undergoing a complete re-development with the major part being the Centre Court upgrade.

As part of the upgrade, new lighting was desired to bring the facility up to a national / international standard (1000 lux per Australian Standard AS2560.2.1) The four existing 20m poles were re-used in their corner positions. Each pole was installed with eight new Philips ArenaVision 2kW floodlights. In addition, Philips Optivision floodlights were positioned under the eaves of the grandstands.



These supplemental flat glass luminaires provide the necessary vertical illumination for television coverage to CIE 169.



The youngest member of the Gerard Lighting group we are please to announce the arrival of Pierlite Malaysia. Established in 2008 after many years of operation as an agent.


